**Instructions for Accessing IMPD Crime Reports and M.A.P.S. Mapping Tool**

1. Type or copy and paste [www.indycrimewatch.com](http://www.indycrimewatch.com) on your browser.
2. In the **CRIMEWATCH** Menu on the left select: **CRIME REPORTS** (From here you will have access to the M.A.P.S., the Sex Offender Registry, B.O.L.O's (Be On the Look Out), and the Crime Stoppers Wanted Posters (you will need to have "Adobe Flash Player" installed in your device).
3. Select: **M.A.P.S.** (Incident Mapper)
4. In the Menu Box:
  - **Select Incident Type** (Click next)
  - **Select Area of Interest** (Click next)
  - **Select Date Range** (Click Next)
5. Click on: **Submit Request**

On the map you will see different markers at the location of each crime committed in the area you selected. There should also be a list of those incidents on a dropdown box. For additional details of any particular incident, just position the cursor on that incident and click.

To view a Tabular Report of those incidents click on the box that has the green check mark.

To get a print out of the Tabular Report, click on the print box at the bottom of that page.

To get a print out of the map look for the printer icon on the top right corner of the top bar and click print.

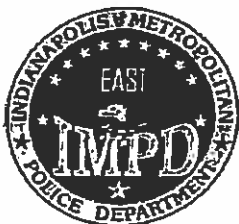

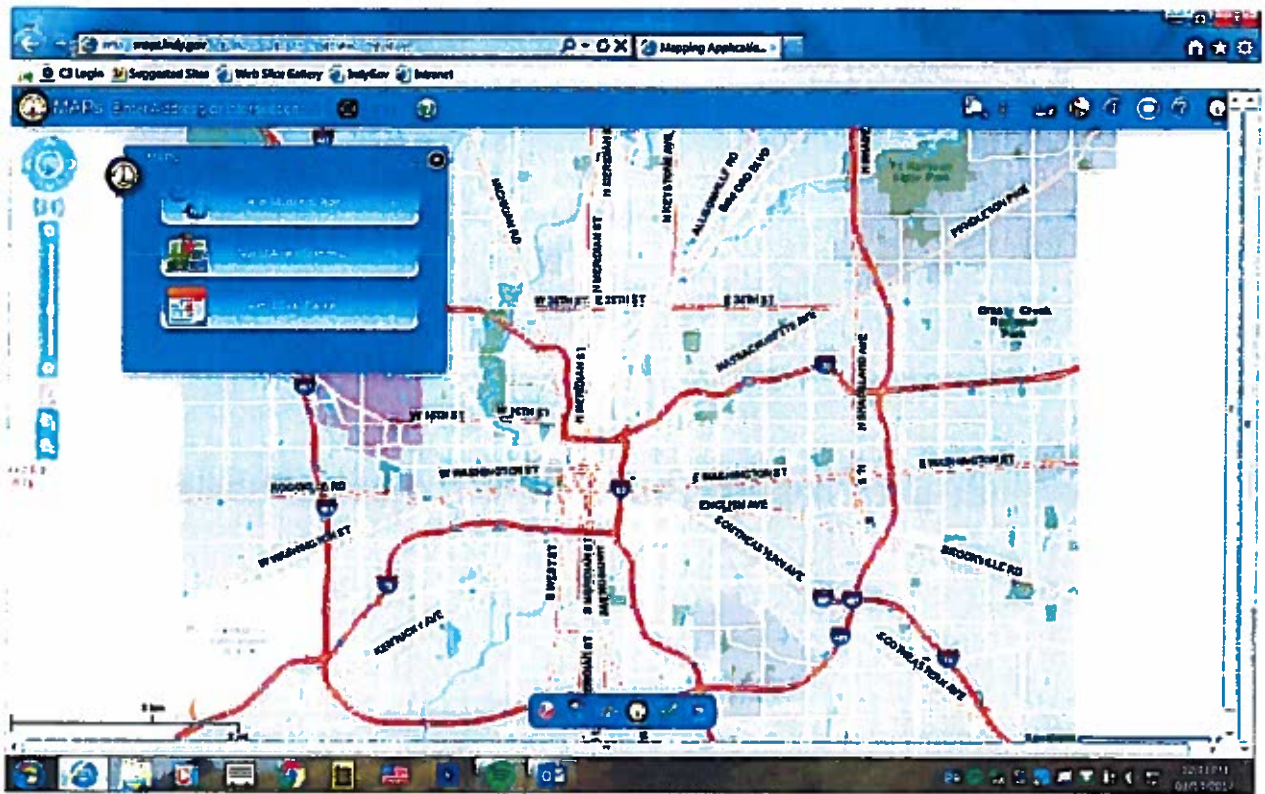

Greetings Neighbor,

Community Hospital East will be starting construction of improvements to 13th Street in mid-April. This work will happen in phases, commencing near the parking garage entrance. While all work will happen in the city easement, we wanted to alert neighbors to the proposed construction schedule. As construction progresses, cones will be set by 7:30 am each day; crews begin work at 8 am and finish by 8 pm.

Enclosed is a map of the construction area to reference with the schedule:

4/17 – 5/26

- Parking garage entrance/exit improvements.

5/9

- Demolition work begins on 13th Street. Road will be open for use.

5/16 – 5/26

- 13th Street – drainage improvements, paving, new sidewalk (on north side). Street access will be maintained, with one side of the street being open at all times. Flaggers will be present at both ends of the work zone for safety and traffic direction.
- Work on the South side of the street will be phased, each resident will be notified when their house is scheduled to be impacted.
- Parking space will be made available to you in the Community Health Network parking lot when access to your drive is limited due to construction. Enter in the hospital main drive, and-drive through the parking garage entrance. Keep to the left to access the parking lot where spaces will be reserved for use by residents (see enclosed map).
- The goal is to complete work on the south side of 13th Street in one week.

Once the work is completed, street parking on the south side of 13th Street will be available. Pending any unforeseen construction or weather delays, work is expected to be completed by the end of May.
