2017 Legislative Session Review

The 2017 Legislative Session has ended, and I believe history will show a mixed bag of results for Hoosiers.

As the Ranking Member of the House Roads and Transportation Committee, much of my energy this session was focused on the proposal to increase funding for state and local road projects.

We all agreed that more funding is required to fix Indiana's existing roads, but we had different ideas about where the funding would come from for these projects. I supported a plan that would have avoided the largest tax increase on Hoosiers in history and would NOT have taken an extra dime out of anyone's pocket.

Instead, a bill was passed that would do the following:

- Increase the state gas tax by 10 cents per gallon starting July 1.
- Require an additional \$15 annual registration fee per vehicle beginning in 2018.
- Authorize the Governor to move forward with tolling existing state highways.

I voted against this proposal, because it relies too much on increased taxes and sacrifices from the average Hoosier.

Here are some updates on other key issues:

Expanding Pre-K

Currently the State is funding a pilot program for a limited number of students in a handful of counties, including Marion County. A bill was passed that extends the pilot program for Marion County and expands it into another 15 counties.

Redistricting Reform

Bills were offered that would have established an independent, bipartisan commission to redraw the legislative district lines. This would put an end to the current system where politicians draw the lines to benefit themselves. Voters should get to pick their politicians, not politicians picking who their voters are. A redistricting reform bill was given a hearing in the Committee on Elections and Apportionment, but the Chair did not allow a vote on the bill after several hours of public testimony.

Strengthening Renew Indy

The City currently uses Renew Indy to help take possession of abandoned and blighted properties and sell them to responsible new owners. A bill was passed to provide funding for Renew Indy and allow properties sold by the City to receive a property tax break as an incentive to help encourage people to buy and fix up abandoned homes.

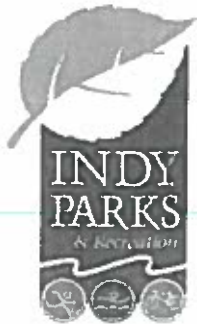
