- State Representative (District 100) - Blake Johnson
 - House - wrapping up pulling bills together as filing deadline is tomorrow at noon - most will not become law
 - Job one is addressing the pandemic - vaccine rollout a bit low
 - 2nd is education and students - teachers have done heroic work over last several months.
 - Other issues - redistricting - would like independent committee to decide on this
 - Commend Crider for working across the aisle
 - Bill might file that lays out a community fridge legislation, or whether to tack on another bill
- State Senator (District 28) - Michael Crider
 - Look forward to working with Rep Johnson
 - Agree that COVID has pushed the state, more than ever anticipated
 - Focus historically on mental health and opioid crisis
 - Chair homeland security and transportation committee, serve on veterans affairs & military and appropriation along with health committee
 - Process is pretty complicated and sometimes your bill can come back and look very different.
 - Looking into how can utilize 988 and funding that comes with it.
 - Food insecure - stretched thin, hope to support
